

How it Works

Each week, from Sunday to Friday, we provide the industry's most advanced and innovative learning opportunities for youth ages 10 to 17 in the safety of a fully supervised day or overnight experience.

Are you a day camper?

No problem. Our flexible schedule will work for your morning or evening commutes. Early drop off and late pickups are included!

Once you're registered, we begin to tailor the experience and curriculum for your child, based on the course they selected. Some campers choose to spend multiple weeks at SummerTech so they can become experts on a single topic such as Animation, 3D Modeling or Coding. Others like to stay and choose a new topic at the beginning of each week.

No matter how long your stay is, you'll get the full SummerTech experience. That includes a **2:1 camper to teacher ratio**, starting from the moment you arrive.

Courses

Tuition

Day Program

The tuition for commuters in 2023 is \$1,450 (credit card) or \$1,400 (check) per week.

This includes everything listed below:

- Personalized Instruction
(including 1:2 Teacher to Camper Ratio)
- Technology and Instructional Materials

- SummerTech T-Shirt

- Complete Supervision

Overnight Program

The tuition for overnights is an extra \$650 per week. This includes everything listed above in addition to breakfast, campus housing, 24-hour supervision and some special surprises just for overnights.

Deposit

A \$600 non-refundable deposit is required for each participant for each week they stay at SummerTech. This deposit goes toward your full tuition payment. The full balance must be received no later than May 1st. We do not prorate fees for those who leave early.

SummerTech Schedule

For Commuters

Commuters should arrive each Sunday at 2:30 PM to check in and get oriented. SummerTech begins at 3:00 PM with an opening ceremony, meetings with staff and campers, first class, fun and games. Dinner is served at 6:00 PM.

Commuters are welcome to stay as late as 9:00 PM for evening social activities which include our famous SummerTech events plus open gaming and outdoor events.

Monday through Friday commuters can be dropped off as early as 8:00 AM. Classes kick-off at 9:00 AM but many usually enjoy arriving early so they can squeeze in some extra free time.

Overnighters

Overnighters arrive on Sunday at 2:00 PM to check in and get situated in their dorm rooms. From there we will give you a tour of our paces and at 3:00 PM SummerTech begins with an opening ceremony, class and elective previews, course selection and every two weeks, gladiatorial combat. Dinner is served at 6:00 PM.

F.A.Q.'s

Q: Can my child bring their own computer?

A: SummerTech provides each child with a dedicated computer along with the latest hardware and software available so that you won't have to worry about bringing your own computer. That said, we won't keep you from bringing your own tech but we don't recommend it and we can't be responsible for any personal items that are lost, stolen or damaged.

Q: How important is it for my child to stay until 9:00 PM each night?

A: SummerTech is nonstop fun and learning, so, by 5:00 PM, we understand if campers want to go home and rest.
